Amount of Scholarship:	Two \$1000 scholarships
Explanation of Award:	The JREC Scholarship is open to any traditional or non-traditional student who is a member of JREC and is presently receiving electric service from the Cooperative.
Application Deadline:	An application form should be completed and returned to Jump River Electric Cooperative on or before June 15.
Selection Criteria:	The Applicant must meet the following criteria to apply: 1. Graduate from their local high school or receive their GED. 2. Display average or above average academic records. 3. Parent(s)/legal guardian of dependent student, or self must be an active member of JREC and presently receive electric service. 4. Display potential to successfully continue achievement in a post-secondary school program which will lead to a diploma in Energy, Agriculture, or Environmental field of work. Eligible career paths include, but are not limited to: • Energy: Careers in renewable energy (solar, wind, hydroelectric), energy management, electrical lineworker, electrical or nuclear engineering, power plant operations, and solar project developer. • Agriculture: Careers in sustainable farming, agribusiness, agricultural engineering, food production, and resource management. • Environmental: Careers in environmental science or engineering, energy efficiency consulting, sustainability consulting, environmental education, and conservation scientists. 5. Family income should not be a deciding factor. 6. Priority will be given to any applicant who has participated in the Youth Leadership Congress, or any youth program offered by JREC.
Selection Committee:	Two recipients will be selected by an outside scholarship committee. 1. None of these should be a relative of an applicant or an employee of JREC. 2. This committee shall select two scholarship recipients from the applications submitted to Jump River Electric Cooperative, Inc., at PO Box 99, Ladysmith, WI 54848, following the June 15 deadline.
Monetary Disbursement:	Recipients will receive the funds when proof of enrollment is furnished to JREC, within one year of the award date.
Alternate Selection:	If a recipient fails to comply with selection criteria, an alternate may be selected and must comply with the above standards.
