

STUDENT SERVICE LEARNING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Graduation Requirements:

As a graduation requirement, Flambeau students must complete **40 hours (Class of 2019: 30 hours, Class of 2020: 30 hours, Class of 2021 and Beyond: 40 hours)** of service learning during their four years of High School. The service projects enable students to work with community leaders and professionals; learn first-hand about some of society's issues, needs, and problems; explore career possibilities; and experience the satisfaction that comes from working without pay to help someone else.

Student responsibilities:

- Need to have service learning **pre-approved** by the Principal if there are questions.
- It is recommended that students do at least 10 hours each year so they don't have to do it all in one year (40).
- Turn in Log at the end of each year or as completed—keeping a copy for their records.
- Provide 5 hours of service to Senior Citizens over the 4 years.
- Cannot count hours volunteered for other Organizations if it is a large group project. (See Principal)

Some areas to consider for Service Learning:

- Nursing Homes (visit, play games, sing)
- Help elderly neighbors
- Environmental Day at school (5 hours each year will be granted)
- Church--teach/help with VBS, Sunday school classes, etc.
- Ring bells for Salvation Army
- Community food pantries
- Indianhead Connections Store
- Animal Shelter
- Teen Court (as long as you are not sanctioned to attend)
- Shop With A Cop
- Community Days in your town
- County Fair
- Manna Meals
- Counselor at 4H camp
- Senior Centers
- Otherways that you may come up with--just have them pre-approved by the Principal.
